



#### **Cross-sectional View**







#### SHIFT SHAFT OIL SEAL







- NGTF0006 Drain fluid from transfer, and drain oil from transmission. 1.
- Remove front and rear propeller shaft. Refer to PD-7, 2. ("Removal and Installation", "PROPELLER SHAFT"). Insert plug into rear oil seal after removing propeller shaft.
- Be careful not to damage spline, sleeve yoke and rear oil • seal, when removing propeller shaft.
- Remove torsion bar spring. Refer to SU-14, ("Torsion Bar 3. Spring", "FRONT SUSPENSION"). Then remove second crossmember.
- 4. Remove exhaust front and rear tubes. Refer to FE-8, ("EXHAUST SYSTEM").
- 5. Disconnect vehicle speed sensor, transfer neutral position switch and 4WD switch harness connectors.
- 6. Remove air breather hose.
- 7. Remove transfer control lever from transfer outer shift lever.
- Separate transfer from transmission. 8.


